The BAG: Post Plan

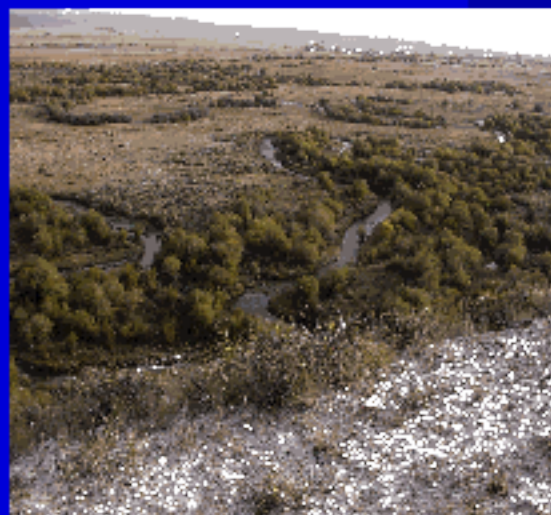


- Because the BAG can provide structure to address local resource issues, it is important to keep the group intact and active.

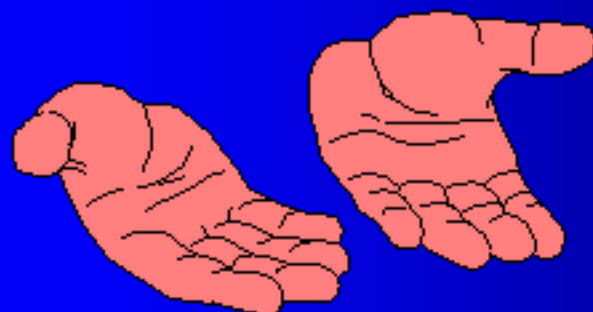
