STATE FRAMEWORK WATER PLAN BAG REPRESENTATIVE CRITERIA

- 1. One representative and one alternate will be chosen from each of the seven basins.
- 2. The representative and/or the alternate should be at each of the 3 progress review meetings that are to be held in either Casper or the Lander/Riverton area. The tentative schedule for these meetings is:

Meeting at 5% completion – March, 2006 Meeting at 50% completion – June, 2006 Meeting at 90% completion – January, 2007

- 3. Per diem and mileage will be paid to the representative or the alternate, whomever attends the meeting. If both the representative and the alternate choose to attend the meeting, only the representative will be paid the per diem. Per Diem and mileage will be reimbursed at the state approved rate.
- 4. The representative and/or the alternate will be responsible for carrying information from the BAG to the Water Development Commission members at the progress review meetings. Additionally, the representative will also be asked to update the BAG on the items discussed at the progress review meetings.
- 5. Ideally, the representative and alternate should have a broad understanding of the issues and a general knowledge of the Basin.
