

Bridger-Teton National Forest Releases Wild and Scenic River Documents for Review



Jackson, Wyo. – The Bridger-Teton National Forest has made available the Draft Snake River Headwaters Comprehensive River Management Plan (CRMP) for public comment until June 30, 2013. Additionally, the Forest is releasing a Forest Plan Amendment/Environmental Assessment (EA) that is also available for public comment until June 30, 2013.

During the public review period, the USFS, NPS and USFWS will hold two joint open houses: Tuesday, June 4 at Moran Elementary School (gymnasium) and Wednesday, June 5, Teton County Library (auditorium). Both are from 4:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. Information on both the USFS and NPS/USFWS plans will be provided and staff will be available to answer questions. A third open house will be held on Tuesday June 11, Thayne Community Center, also from 4:00-7:00 PM. Bridger-Teton National Forest staff will be available to answer questions.
